## **REQUIREMENTS**

- Growing Relationship with Christ
- At least two semesters in a Crossbridge community group (before leading one)
- Church Partner
- Time, Capacity, Discernment
- Agreeing to hold to a Biblical standard as defined in 1 Timothy 3:8-13\*.
- Agreeing to hold to the values and principles of Crossbridge, as well as it's leadership.

## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

- Organize and Attend Weekly Meetings
- Take Group Attendance
- Begin and end on time
- Communicate with Group Members
- Create an Environment of Growth, Sharing and Discipleship
- Pray & Care for Group Members
- Invite & Welcome Others to Your Group
- Raise Up New Leaders
- Multiply Your Group
- Meet with Your coach
- Attend Trainings
- \* Our group leaders serve the role of deacons in the life of our church. In 1 Timothy 3:8-13, Paul outlines a standard for deacons which is also the standard we have set for community group leaders.
- <sup>8</sup> In the same way, deacons are to be worthy of respect, sincere, not indulging in much wine, and not pursuing dishonest gain. <sup>9</sup> They must keep hold of the deep truths of the faith with a clear conscience. <sup>10</sup> They must first be tested; and then if there is nothing against them, let them serve as deacons.
- <sup>11</sup> In the same way, the women are to be worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything.
- <sup>12</sup>A deacon must be faithful to his wife and must manage his children and his household well. <sup>13</sup>Those who have served well gain an excellent standing and great assurance in their faith in Christ Jesus. 1 Timothy 3:8-13
